3. Hazards Identification

4. First Aid Measures

EYE CONTACT: For eyes, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes & get medical attention.

SKIN CONTACT: In case of contact with skin immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap & water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

INHALATION: After high vapor exposure, remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has stopped, trained personnel should immediately begin artificial respiration. If the heart has stopped, trained personnel should immediately begin cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). **CALL A PHYSICIAN immediately!**

5. Fire-fighting Measures

HANDLING
